The Game of "Carom-9-Ball" 3-cushion Billiard game

1. Billiards:

- 1. Billiard: the cue ball contacts all (2) object balls without fault(s). (3 object balls in Jumbo)
- 2. 3-cushion billiard: a billiard with the cue ball hits rails at least three times before contacting the last object ball. (A billiard in this article is referred to a 3-cushion billiard)
- 3. A bank-shot billiard: A billiard with the cue ball hits the rail(s) before contacting other ball(s).
- 4. A kiss-shot (time-shot) billiard: a billiard made with at least one of the following two conditions:
 - 1. The cue ball contacts non-last object ball more than once before the billiard is made.
 - 2. The first object ball contacts other object ball(s) before the billiard is made.
- 5. A special billiard: A bank- shot or a predeclared kiss-shot billiard. (or agreed among players),
- 6. billiard made without a kiss is not valid if predeclared as a kiss shot.

2. Game:

- 1. Game starts as score 1 to 0. (Take away most the advantage of the break.)
- 2. Each player has his rating and legitimate cue ball(s).
- 3. Player always plays with the lower/equal score, and shoots until he fails to make a billiard.
- 4. All billiard points add to lower or equal side of two scores.
- 5. FIVE ways to WIN: (if not at break, and must without fault, mulligan, or switching cue ball)
 - 1. Make a 9 or more run, before any point scored, special billiard requirement is exempted (AKA: classic challenge, or CC win, or grand-slam win if it is from a break shot)
 - 2. Make the low-score reach 9, with run equal or more billiards than the player's rating. (Challenge-Number, or CN: defined as 9.5 minus the lower/equal score.)
 - 3. Make the lower-score reach or over 9, with at least one special billiard in that inning.
 - 4. Make 4 special-billiards in a row. (AKA: a JACKPOT win)
 - 5. Make 4 kiss-billiards in a row. (no declaration needed, AKA: a Super-JACKPOT win)
 - 6. All points after winning shot or beyond 17-total are bonus-points. (for betting or tie-breaker)
 - 7. A special billiard is required for player rated (+), except for a CC win.
 - 8. A predeclared kiss- billiard is required for player rated (a), except for a CC win.
 - 9. A kiss-billiard plus a special-billiard is required for player rated (a+), except for a CC win.
 - 10. If at break, other player(s) may play the same break shot, higher score wins. If same score, match(es) starts over, all billiards made count as bonus. A tie is also permitted.
- 3. Rating: Every player has a rating. Usually self-rated. (or by tournament director)
 - 1. Highest rating is 9, reserved for the best player ever, now, and forever; so never.
 - 2. Lowest rating is 1. World-class/pro: 7a, 7aa, 8+, 8a, 8a+, 8aa+, 8aaa... (myself: 5+ /5a).
- 4. Penalty, Faults etc:
 - 1. Lost turn: fault(s) without partner's consent, switching cue ball within inning, or touching ball(s) without partner(s)' consent.
 - 2. Intentional fault, player touches the balls after any one ball has hit two rails. The next player may spot any ball(s) to its/their initial setup position(s).
 - 3. CAN NOT win at that inning, but shooter may finish his inning, all billiard counts.
 - 1. Not using his legitimate cue-ball(s).
 - 2. Takes a mulligan. (must be with partner's consent).
 - 3. Move the position of any ball. (must be with partner's consent)
 - 4. If shooter's cue ball is frozen to other ball(s), shooter may gently drop a chalk to separate them.
 - 5. Initial setup and Break-shot: (head and foot side inter-changeable)
 - 1. Red ball at center and the other cue ball at the foot spot.
 - 2. Cue ball anywhere from the head spot to the center of head-side short rail.
 - 3. Player shoots forward (toward other balls, bank shot ok) only.
 - 4. Players rated 8 or higher use tougher break setup. (TBD)
- 5. Challenges: other player(s) buy
 - 1. Dinner challenge: Grand slam and CC win. (see if the house or sponsor buys all players a drink!?)
 - 2. Lunch Challenge: wins when the winning number (CN) is greater than 8.
 - 3. Beer Challenge: any JACKPOT win, or wins when the CN is greater than the shooter's rating.
 - 4. Holey shots ??? sprcial interesting shots/billiards deserve special rewards .
